New Procedure for Accepting Credit Cards

If you prefer to make payment using a credit card (**VISA/MC/AMEX/DISCOVER**), it is imperative that you complete the entire application form and return via

When the completed application is received, an Electronic Invoice will be created and sent to the Email Address you provided. The Invoice will be issued by the IAMC and will reflect the Dues and Contributions you wish to make from the menu above. When you have received the invoice, please click on the box marked "Pay Invoice" and follow prompts to process your payment. All credit card transactions are safe and simple, but do require a 3.25% service fee be added to your invoice. If you have any questions, please call K. Cortese at 630-868-2610.

Dues or contributions to the IAMC are not deductible as a charitable expense for federal tax purposes but may be deductible as a reasonable and necessary business expense. Dues attributable to lobbying expenses are not deductible and the IAMC estimates that 10% of dues are attributable to lobbying. Voluntary contributions to "IVPAC" (the Illinois Vendors Political Action Committee) are not tax deductible and a copy of our IVPAC report is on file with the Illinois State Board of Elections.
